Statement of Yashomoti Parekh (52 yrs)

w/O Magandas Parekh of 757A & B, Paamapukur Road, Cal-20,  
Flat No. 3A.

My particulars stated above. I am living at the aforesaid premises with my husband Magandas Parekh, son-Bhabesh Parekh (19yrs) and youngest daughter- Hetal Parekh (18yrs). Since May 1987. My husband is a business man having his office at 71, Canning Street, Shop No. C/32. My son is studying at Bhawanipur Education Society and my daughter studying at Wellend & Goldsmith School, Bowbazar.

In the morning at about 09.00 hrs. my husband left for his business place every day. My son usually returned back from his college at about 11.30 hrs. and after taking his meal left for his father's business place. My daughter's examination (I.C.S.C) is going on now.

Today morning my husband and son left as usual and my daughter left the residence at 07.30 hrs. in the morning to Seat for her examination (I.C.S.C) at Wellend & Goldsmith School, Bowbazar. She came residence at about 13.00 hrs. Everyday at about 5/5.30 P.M. I go to Lachmi Narayan Mandir at Sarat Bose Road.

To day (5.3.90) at about 5.20 p.m. as usual I left for the temple where my daughter was alone at our flat. I went down by lift and Ramdhari was the Liftman. I came back from temple at about 6.05 p.m. As I entered in the Lift the Liftman Ramdhari told me that our security guard Dhananjay Chatterjee had gone to our flat to telephone the Security Agency. I expressed my disapproval for Dhananjay's going to my flat for telephone. After reaching my flat I rung the bell but the door was not opened. I rung the bell again and again and also knocked at the door but still the door was not opened from

from inside. \*I was also shouted and call my daughter to open the door but in vain. Being attracted by my shout-people from different flats collected in front of my flat and door was forced opened. On entering the flat I found the door of the bed room where I and my husband slept was lying open and my daughter-Hetal Parekh was lying in the floor in front of the door- I found that she was practically naked lying on her back, her inside skirt and blouse was pulled up and her private parts and breast were visible. There was patch of blood near her head and blood drops on the floor. Her both the hands had blood stains wearing apparels also had blood stains. There was also blood on her face. Her wearing Party was lying near the entrance door. My daughter was unconscious as if appear to me. I took her down stairs immediately for taking her to Hospital. But in the meantime some of our neighbourers called in a doctor who examined her and proclaimed her dead. At about 7 p.m. my son came back. Prior to the coming of my son Dr. Kirtika Babisi also was called who also after examination proclaimed my daughter dead. After my son has come back I brought back of my daughter to our flat and laid her on the bed in her bed-room and covered her with a piece of Cheddar. My husband returned to residence at about 8.30 p.m. and thereafter he rang up police. In this connection I like to mention that my daughter Hetal earlier complained me in several times that the Security Guard Dhananjay Chatterjee passed remarks and teased her while she went to school or come back from the school.

I strongly suspect Dhananjay Chatterjee for committing murder of my daughter and even committing rape on my daughter
