card for the sale of a Rico Ladies wrist watch sold
from my shop on 21.2.90 which has been written and
signed by me. The wrist watch was sold to one Jashomati
Parekh of 57A and B, Padma Pukur Road, Calcutta-20. The
price of the wrist watch was Rs.350/-. The document
is marked ext.15.

X-examination on behalf of aced.

I cannot say who brought the guarantee card
from my shop. I cannot say at whose instance I wrote
the name of Jashomati Parekh in the guarantee card.
I do not know Jashomati Parekh. We maintain a register
for record of the transaction on a particular day from
our shop. We make entry of the particulars of the wrist

watch sold from our shop on a particular day. The cashmemo is also granted for the sale of the wrist watch. I cannot say if the cashmemo and the particular register relating to the sale of the particular wrist watch had ever been shown to police. I cannot say the wrist watch sold from my shop contained what particulars. I personally sold out the particular wrist watch of which I have spoken in my examination in chief. Attendance register is maintained in our shop for recording the attendance of the employees working there. I cannot say if the attendance register showing my attendance in the shop on the particular day had been made available to police. Not a fact that the particular wrist watch was not sold out to Jashomati Parekh and that I have written the guarantee card at the dictation of the owner of the shop where I work and that no Biscoe Ladies wrist watch had been sold from our shop in the name of Jashomati Parekh on 21.2.90.
