EXTERNAL APPEARANCE:

1. Condition of subject-stout, emaciated, decomposed etc.
Average built female subject, complexion fair,
eyes partially closed, Cornea hazy, pupils dilated,
Scalp hair 15" long all black matted with blood,

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Rigor motis present all over, FMS on the back, Cyanosis present over the finger tips, nails & ear lobules. Face congested. Wearing apparel- one dark colour half sleeve Ganjee with evidence of recent tear round the neck, one brassier., Belonging one Chaddar, Evidence of blood stained discharge present from nostrils, face, "gajee" blood stained. Evidence of matting of pubic hair on right side.

Injuries:- (1) Contusion 3" x 2 1/2" with multiple abrasion over it, 7 in number of sizes varying from 3/4" x 1/2" to 1/2" x 1/4" on left side of neck, 1" above the level of suprasternal notch and 2" behind and left of middle, (2) Contusion 4" x 2" with multiple abrasions of sizes varying from 1" x 1/2" to 3/4" x 1/2" over right side of neck, 2" behind and right of midline and 1" above the right clavicle. (3) Abrasions 4 in number of sizes varying from 3/4" x 1/4" to 1/2" x 1/2" over left side of face, 2" anterior to left angle of mandible and 1" above the lower border of Mandible, (4) Abrasions 2 in Nos. of sizes 1" x 1/2" to 1/8" x 1/8" over left side of face, 1/2" below the injury No. 3, (5) one abrasion on 2" x 1/2" placed 1" below the chin, over middle, (6) Abrasion 2 1/2" x 1" over right side of face, 1" midline and 1" above the lower border of mandible, (6) Abrasion 3/4" x 1/4" over right side of face, 3/4" right to angle of mouth & 1 1/2" above the lower border of mandible, (7) lacerated wound 1/2" x 1/8" x muscle over bridge of nose, 1/2" below the fronto nasal junction. On dissection, there was comminuted fracture of nasal bones, (8) Abra-

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(8) Abrasion $\frac{1}{2}$ " x $\frac{1}{2}$ " over tip of nose, (9) Lacerate wound $\frac{3}{4}$ " x $\frac{1}{2}$ " x muscle over inner aspect of lower lip, $\frac{1}{2}$ " left to mid line, (10) One abrasion $\frac{1}{2}$ " x $\frac{1}{2}$ " over fronto nasal junction, (11) One contusion 2" x 2" covering both lids of left eye and adjacent part of left side of the head. (12) Haematoma $\frac{1}{2}$ " x $\frac{1}{2}$ ", medial aspect of conjunction of left eye, (13) Abrasion $\frac{3}{4}$ " x $\frac{1}{2}$ " over Right frontal eminence, (14) Abrasions 2 in Nos. each of size 2" x $\frac{1}{3}$ " over medial aspect of left upper arm, 5" above the level of left elbow joint, (15) One contusion $\frac{3}{4}$ " x $\frac{3}{4}$ " over posterior aspect of left elbow joint, (16) Abrasion $\frac{3}{4}$ " x $\frac{1}{2}$ " over Posterior aspect of left ~~be~~ elbow joint, 6/3, (17) Abrasions 2 in Nos. each of size $\frac{1}{8}$ " x $\frac{1}{8}$ " lateral aspect of right hip joint, 4" below the level of highest point of iliac crest, (18) Extra vassation of blood in the subcutaneous tissue and muscle on the left side of neck over an area of 3" x 2" corresponding to injury No. 1, (19) Extra vassation of blood present in and around the larynx, Trachea and Oesophagus, corresponding to injuries No. 1 and 2 (20) Extra vassation of 2" x 1" over the ventral aspect of sterno clavicular junction, (21) Fracture and dislocation of hyoid bone on its greater cornua of left side. All the injuries showed evidence of vital reaction. No other injury could be detected even after careful dissection and examination. The abrasions were red in colour and uncrusted. The contusions were of red in colour. The margins of lacerated wound were irregular and reddish in colour. The whole of the stomach and its content, a loop of

of intestine, a portion of the [✓]liver, half of each kidney preserved in S.S. of common salt. The sample of preserved viscera, sample of scalp hair, finger nail cuttings and scrappings, Post Mortem blood, wearing apparel, matted part of pubic hair cut as preserved and all handed over to the accompanying police Constable for sending it to the Chemical Examiner. The colour of the margins of ruptured hymen and the extravasation there was reddish in colour.
