The parcels consisted of one partially paper covered
 surmica top wooden cradle (A), two paper packets (B, W.) one
 Polythene packet (U) and eight envelopes (C, V, X, X1, X2, X3,
 Y, S) of which parcels A, B, C were sealed with impressions of
 a seal corresponding with the seal impression forwarded, and
 with the seal of BHOWANIPUR P.S. the parcels U & R V were
 sealed with forwarding seal impression only and the rest
 were sealed with forwarding seal impression, and with the
 seal of CALCUTTA POLICE MORGUE.

Description of Articles contained in Parcel.

The sumica top wooden cradle (A) with four metallic rings bear dark stains on sumica top swab in cotton was collected from stained area for serological examination.

The paper packet (B) contained two screw and one latch lock bearing dark brown spots at places. Swab in cotton from stained area was collected for Serological examination.

The envelope (C) contained one button bearing Max no visible stains.

The polythene packet (U) contained one cream colour self design full sleeve open breast shirt bearing no visible stains.

The envelope (Wx V) contained one Godrej Key (bearing No. 535362 bore no visible stains).

The paper packet (W) contained one lace fitted cream colour brassiere bearing dark brown stains on back strap and pasty on body, one torn, black colour, half sleeve, round neck, Ganji bearing dark brown stains at places, one old Chadar bearing dark brown stains at places.

The envelope X contained two filter papers bearing dark brown stains. The unstained portion of the same were used as control. This was said to be blood of accused soaked in blotting paper.

The envelope (X1) contained one glass vial containing bright red liquid said to be blood of accused.

The envelope (X2) contained one glass vial containing bright red liquid said to be blood of accused. The envelope (X3) contained one glass vial containing bright red liquid said to be blood of accused.

The contents of glass vials X1, X2, X3 were soaked in orange cloth for Serological examination.

The envelope 'Y' contained some hair said to be sample of Pubic hair of accused Dharenjoy Chatterjee. It has been preserved for comparison with the hair found in packet D in connection with the case as mentioned above received in this office under Memo No. of D.C.(LD), Lalbazar 660-IL/HM dated 16.3.90.

The envelope 'Z' contained one test tube containing turbid liquid which was soaked in cotton-wool for Serological Examination.

RESULTS OF EXAMINATION.

No blood could be detected on the exhibits marked B (two screw) & C(Button).

Blood was detected in the stains on each of the exhibits marked A(Cradle) B (latch lock), W(Brassiere, Gajji & Chadar), X(Filter paper) as well as in the contents of the three glass vials marked X1 (Bright red liquid), X2(Bright red liquid) & X3(Bright red liquid).

Semen was detected in the contents of the test tube enclosed within the envelope marked X (turbid liquid).

Regarding origin and group of blood in A, B, W, X, X1, X2 and X3 and origin and Group of semen in Z, the report of the Serologist No.8697/MLR dt.25.10.90 is enclosed.

Result of Analysis

The number noted below refer to my number.

Item Nos. 23, 24, 26, 28, 27 and 28 noted above are stained with human blood.

The blood stains on the item Nos. 20, 21 and 22 are disintegrated and their origin cannot be determined. The semen stains on the item No. 29 are disintegrated and their origin cannot be determined.

REPORT ON BLOOD AND SEMEN GROUP.

Item Nos. 23 and 24 are stained with 'B' and 26 and 27 are stained with 'O' Group Blood.

The blood and semen group of the stains on the items noted below could not be determined for the reasons stated :-

Item Nos. 25 and 28 : Not sufficient for test.

Item Nos. 20, 21 and 28 (Blood) : Disintegrated.

Item No. 29 (Semen) : Disintegrated.
