Hetal Parekh case at Mamata door



KOLKATA: A group of social activists submitted a deputation at Nabanna addressing chief minister Mamata Banerjee on Thursday seeking a reinvestigation into the murder of student Hetal Parekh, for which Dhananjay Chatterjee was hanged in 2004.

Nearly 1,000 people signed the petition, arguing that a recent book written by ISI professors Prabal Choudhury, Debashis Sengupta and researcher Paramesh Goswami has pointed at major loopholes in the probe and the judgment. The deputation requested the CM to reinvestigate the matter in order to 'posthumously relieve Chatterjee of the shame' and identify the real perpetrators of the crime.
