I, S.I. G.P. Som of Sec. T held inquest over the dead body of Miss Hetal Parekh by touching it in presence of witnesses.

She was found lying on her back being covered with a Chaddar upto her neck on the cot of her room situated at the Western side in the flat No. 3A or 3rd floor of 'ANAND' partment at 57/A & B, Padmapukur Road. Her head was towards East legs towards West having bleeding injuries on her nose and stains of blood could be noticed on her face. The said Chaddar was removed from her body. She was wearing dark colour half sleeve ganjse with mark of tear near its neck. She was about 5' in height and was thin built having fair complexion. The following injuries could be detected apparently on her body:-
(1) Multiple abrasion on left and right side of her neck and face (2) Abrasion over the tip of nose, (3) one lacerated injury on the inner side of lower lip (4) one lacerated injury over the bridge of nose, (5) Abrasion of left arm and on right hip joint. She is being sent for P.M. Examination to ascertain the actual cause of death.
