The glass jar marked 2 contained some salt solution said to be a sample of preservative used in the above viscera.

The glass jar marked 3 contained some dark and liquid said to be the sample of blood of Hetal Parekh.

RESULT OF EXAMINATION.

Exhibits are destroyed after six months if not requisitioned for return earlier through proper channel.

No poison could be detected either in the viscera or in the blood said to be Hetal Parekh.
